DEFINITION

The *PCI Contact* is a swivelling target-holder (hostile/neutral/non-hostile) for short-range shooting-stand training. It is intended for users of firearms:

- Public security forces: police, gendarmerie, counter-terrorism forces and intervention units.
- Customs officers, prison staff, railway security guards, etc.
- Private security companies.
- Sports shooting clubs.

OPERATION

It can be controlled easily by a 7" smartphone or tablet. The downloadable Android app is user-friendly and provides easy management of target-holders.

The app can also be used to set "Display" times for targets, choice of positions, scenarios to be executed and counting of impacts.

Features

The *PCI Contact* can be used with or without impact detection, and with or without a tablet/smartphone.

Impact detection is adapted to all calibres of weapons currently issued.

Impact detection works on targets of different materials (wood, plastic, metal, etc.).

Display times (hostile/neutral/non-hostile) are programmable.

Number of impacts necessary for a target to be taken out can be programmed.

"Random" mode available.

Visual feedback on the outcome of the shot is available immediately.

Impacts on hostile and non-hostile sides counted separately.

Helps trainees focus on target discernment before shooting (identification of hostile/non-hostile targets).

The duration of target display times can be adjusted for rapid-fire training.

Target movements simulate realistic conditions and situations.

Use

The *PCI Contact* has been designed for use in instruction and training to help users improve their handling of small arms and light weapons, by creating realistic operational situations.
